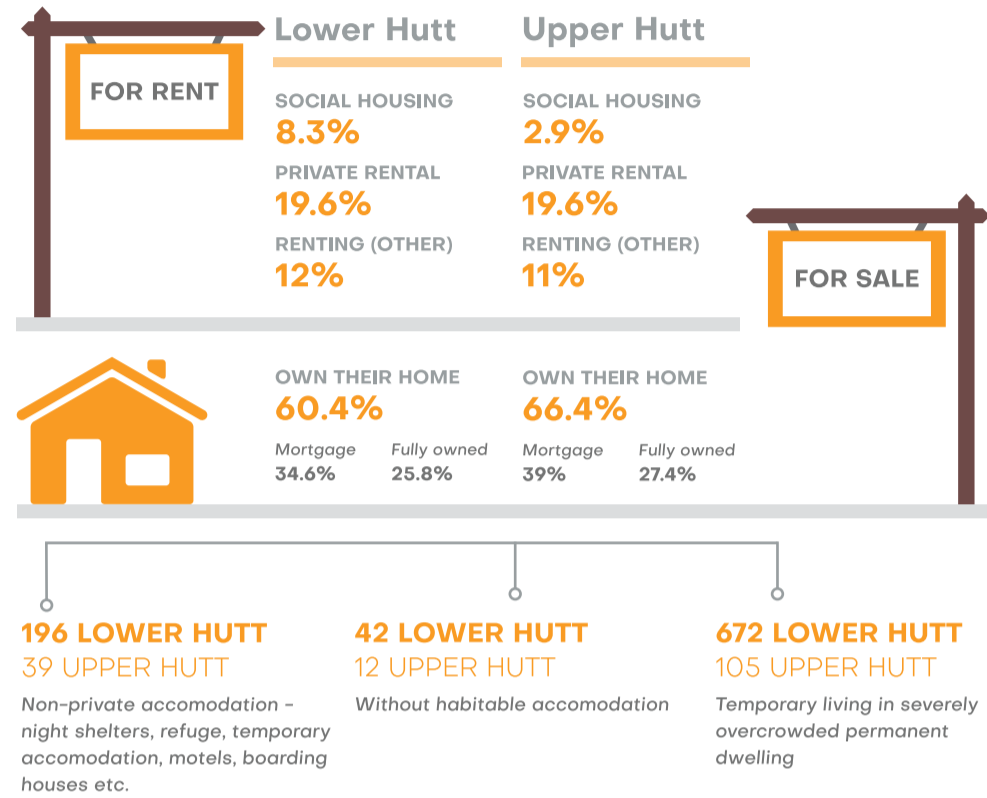


WHAT IS IT LIKE FOR MY HOUSEHOLD IN THE HUTT VALLEY?

80% of our **HEALTH AND WELLBEING** is determined through our **SOCIAL, ECONOMIC and PHYSICAL ENVIRONMENTS (50%)** and our behaviours (30%).
Only 20% is determined by our access to and quality of health care.

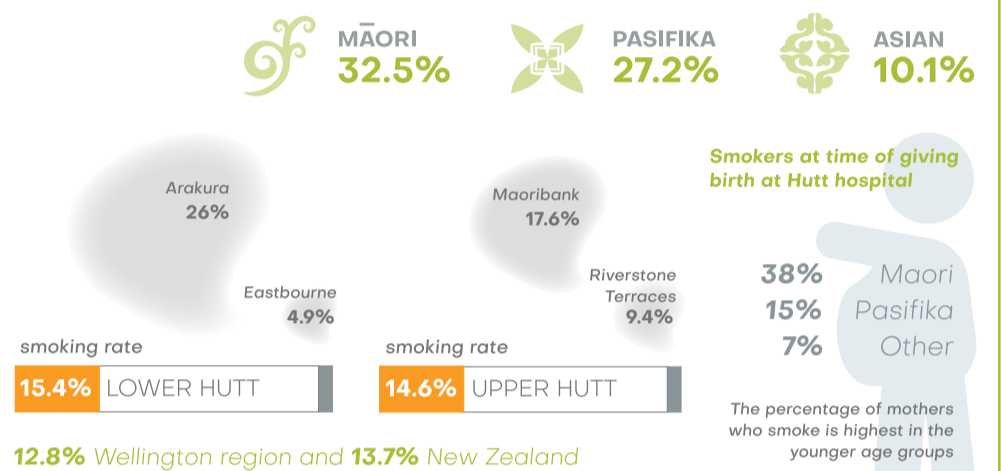
Māori and Pasifika people in the Hutt Valley are more physically active than those living in the rest of NZ

Drinkers in most deprived areas are 1.5 times more likely to be hazardous drinkers than in least deprived

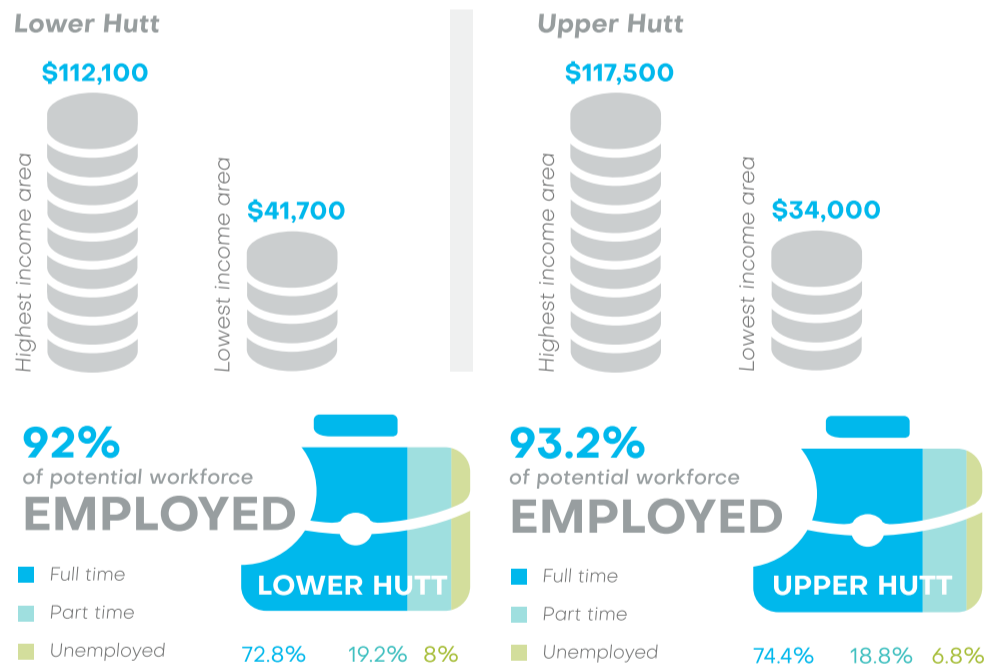

Between Sept 2017-Sept 2018 average **RENTAL COSTS** in Lower Hutt increased by **10%**

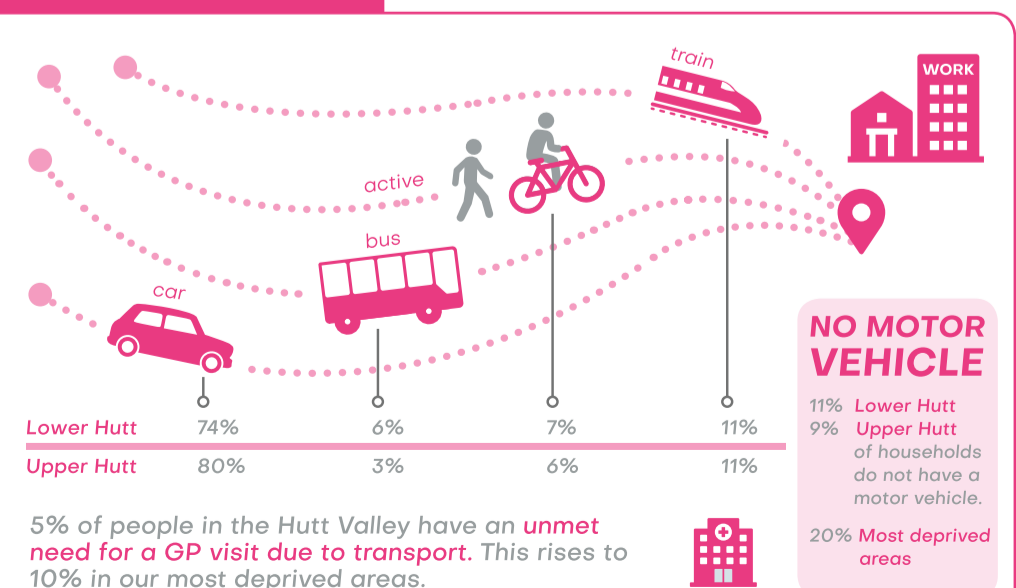
Between Sept 2017-Sept 2018 average **HOUSE PRICES** in Lower Hutt increased by **9%**












Since 2013 median house prices in the lowest income areas have doubled. In the highest income areas the increase is only a 1/3.



20% of people in the Hutt Valley have an **unmet need for a GP visit due to cost**. This rises to 28% in our most deprived areas.
